

WESCO WARRANTY & OPERATOR'S MANUAL FOR WESCO BOAT TRAILERS

A regular maintenance program should be implemented to help assure you of dependable service from your WESCO Trailer. The recommended maintenance is stated below.

TIRES: Improper inflation will increase wear on a tire. Please check the inflation levels periodically (check the sidewall for the manufacturers' recommended pressure). Also, have tires balanced periodically. **Keeping the lug nuts tight is the owner's responsibility.** Lug nuts on all rims should be checked before you tow your trailer for the first time and at 50 mile and 100-mile increments to ensure they are tight.

WHEEL BEARINGS: Periodically check the amount of grease in the hubs. If more is needed remove cap and insert grease through the zerk fitting in the spindle on the axle. The hubs are a sealed unit and only require periodic maintenance or lubrication. **Bearing maintenance is the owner's responsibility.**

LUBRICATION: Proper lubrication will reduce friction between moving parts. Any working parts should be lubricated occasionally. Good lubrication will prolong the life of these parts.

LIGHTS: Your WESCO Boat Trailer is equipped with lighting, which should be tested after attaching the trailer to the vehicle. Check turn signals, brake lights, clearance lights and wiring for proper working condition.

TONGUE JACK: It is important not to overextend your jack; doing so will strip or even break the gears.

BRAKES: The brake fluid reservoir should be checked periodically to ensure minimum fluid levels are present. Use DOT 3 brake fluid for your brake system. Free backing trailer requires trailer harness to be connected to tow vehicle. Reverse solenoid locks out the brakes when powered by tow vehicle through trailer harness. Brakes should be washed down immediately after use in saltwater. Trailers equipped with Electric Over Hydraulic (EOH) require an in cab brake controller to operate EOH unit. Some vehicles require manual set up for EOH to function properly. Refer to your vehicle owner's manual for set up requirements.

SALTWATER: Saltwater increases wear on the trailer. If you use your WESCO trailer in saltwater rinse the trailer with fresh water immediately after using it.

DO NOT OVERLOAD TRAILER CAPACITY! For your protection, you may wish to stock a few extra supplies for your trailer. A spare tire and wheel, wheel bearings, bearing grease, taillight bulbs, tie-down lines and road flares may all be useful items to have on hand.

LIMITED WARRANTY FOR WESCO TRAILERS MANUFACTURED BY W.C. MANUFACTURING AND SPECIALTY INC.

We warranty each new Wesco trailer (hereafter referred to as "Product") manufactured by W.C. Manufacturing and Specialty Inc. to be free from defects in material and workmanship to the **original purchaser and is nontransferable**.

This warranty shall become effective **only upon receipt of a completed Owner Warranty Registration** which shall identify the Products registered by the VIN (Vehicle Identification Number). This warranty is as follows:

- Trailer - 1 year from date of purchase (refer to exclusions) – Coupler to Tail light
- But not to exceed 2 years from date of manufacture

W. C. Manufacturing & Specialty Co. Inc. warrants the following parts to be free from defects in material and workmanship: winch stand assembly, tongue assembly, frame assembly, and brackets manufactured by W. C. Manufacturing & Specialty Co. Inc. All other components are warranted by component manufacturer. Please contact Wesco Trailers to submit warranty claim for prior authorization.

Exclusions

If any Wesco Trailer is purchased or used for rental or other commercial purposes, or for/by a corporation, partnership, company, organization, or association including without limitation camps, clubs, resorts, schools, or the like, then the term of this Limited Warranty is limited to a period of ninety (90) days after the date of original retail purchase.

Since this warranty applies to defects in material and workmanship, it does not apply to normal wear and tear, neglect, lack of maintenance, accident, abnormal operation, racing competition or any commercial services.

This warranty does **NOT** cover:

Normal discoloration, dulling, or hazing of any associated material.

Damage to or deterioration of the wood, carpet or plastic due to UV exposure.

Damage or deterioration of the wood, carpet, or plastic due to alterations, exposure to fuel, harsh solvents, or other chemicals.

This warranty does **NOT** cover product that:

Has not been assembled, used, and maintained in accordance with the instructions or the owner's manual accompanying the Product.

Has been damaged in an accident.

Has been abused, misused, or improperly operated.
Has been repaired, modified, or tampered with by someone other than the original Manufacturer, or authorized repair shop per Wesco Trailers
Has been damaged because of shipping, warehousing, or storage.

This warranty will not apply to: Haul-out, launching, towing charges, storage charges, telephone or rental charges of any type, expense of travel, lodging, gasoline, personal injury, inconvenience, or loss of time and income or revenue.

All incidental and consequential damages are excluded from this warranty. Implied warranties are limited to the life of this warranty. Any statements, representations or warranties given by dealers or third persons other than those provided herein are not covered.

Promotional items that are free or are given at no charge, are excluded from the warranty.

Due to the highly corrosive conditions a trailer is exposed to rust formation, wood degradation and carpet are not covered. Damage caused by abuse, negligence, vandalism, lack of maintenance, improper storage, accident, or overloading. Trailer altered or modified in any way. Use of improperly installed weight distribution hitches in conjunction with hydraulic surge brakes. Damage caused by natural occurrences such as flooding, hurricanes, tornados etc. Any additional damage caused by the owner's failure to promptly notify a WESCO dealer or W. C. Manufacturing & Specialty Co. of a defect discovered within 30 days after such a discovery.

This submission does not guarantee the claim will be covered by this warranty. The claim will be submitted for review and you will be contacted by a member of our warranty team.

The Product will be brought to Wesco Trailers, 1059 Colite Drive, W Columbia, SC 29170, provided such service is covered under this warranty. The Purchaser shall pay for all related transportation charges. All shipping expenses related to a warranty claim are the Purchaser's responsibility. If the service is not covered by this warranty, the purchaser shall pay for all related labor and material and any other expenses associated with that service. Any Product or parts shipped by Purchaser for inspection or repair must be shipped with transportation charges prepaid.

Wesco Trailers and/or W.C. Manufacturing and Specialty Co. has no obligation under this warranty, or shall be limited to repairing a defective part, or at our option replacing such part or parts as shall be necessary to remedy any malfunction resulting from defects in material or workmanship as covered by this warranty. We reserve the right to improve or change the design of any Product without assuming any obligation to modify any Product previously manufactured.

This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other legal rights, which may vary

from area to area.

Please note that in an unlikely event that received merchandise, or any of its parts need to be replaced for any reason, Wesco Trailers, W.C. Manufacturing and Specialty Inc. will deliver replacement parts ONLY within the lower 48 states. Customers outside of the US are responsible for shipping, customs, duties or taxes charges associated with shipping of merchandise from US to destinations abroad.

Manufacturer's sole obligation and buyer's sole and exclusive remedy, under this warranty shall be the repair or replacement, at manufacturer's option and subject to the terms and conditions of this warranty, of any part or parts which are determined by the manufacturer to be defective. Without limiting the foregoing, under no circumstances shall the manufacturer be liable for any incidental, special, consequential, contingent, or punitive damages, for any breach of warranty.

Limitation and Disclaimer of Warranty

Except as herein above set forth, manufacturer makes no warranty of any kind, express or implied, and the limited warranty herein above set forth is expressly in lieu of any warranties and representations, express or implied, and all other obligations or liabilities on the part of manufacturer. If, without limiting and notwithstanding the foregoing, any warranty shall be limited in duration to the term of the repair or replacement warranty provided herein without application of extended warranty.

Limitations of Remedies

Water activities are, by their nature, hazardous. Therefore, some or all of the limitations and/or exclusions or warranties and remedies set forth above may not apply to you. This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state.

Severability

If any provision of this Limited Warranty is unenforceable, for any reason, all other provisions hereof shall remain in full force and effect.

Release

Recognizing that trailering a boat poses a potential hazard to others, the buyer freely and willingly waives all claims to injury to himself or damage to purchased trailer arising out of the improper use. Further, in consideration of the permission of use granted, buyer hereby releases Wesco Trailers, W.C. Manufacturing and Specialty Co. its directors, officers, representatives, agents, and employees from any and all liability for injury of any kind to buyer, the trailer or other property buyer may have, incurred by reason of any act or failure to act, on buyer part, or W.C. Manufacturing and Specialty, its directors, officers, representatives, agents, and employees, arising because of the use of above mentioned Wesco Trailer purchased from Wesco Trailers, W C Manufacturing and Specialty Co.

Owners Must Read Before Towing

1. Be sure that the weight on the ball is approximately 10%-15% of the total weight of the boat, motor, and fuel.
2. Check for the correct ball size and towing capacity.
3. Be sure the frame of the trailer is parallel with the towing surface.
4. Be sure the coupler is on the ball and the securely latched over the ball.
5. Be sure safety chains are crossed and secured to towing vehicle properly.
6. Be sure tongue jack is retracted and properly secured.
7. Make sure lug nuts are torqued to 90 lbs.
8. Be sure tires are inflated to recommended tire pressure. This information is located on the side wall of the tire.
9. Be sure to maintain grease levels in hubs.
10. Check all lights- side markers, stop indicators, and turn signals-- for proper operation.
11. If the trailer is equipped with brakes, check master cylinder for adequate level of brake fluid. Refer to the



Actuator owner's manual. Also, be sure to hook up breakaway cable to towing vehicle.
12. Have boat securely fastened at bow eye and transom.
